What is the **title** of your initiative? Get WITH it! (Walking In The Halls)

Give us a **snapshot** of what it's about – what organizations are involved, who it's targeting...

- Community walking program for community members of all ages in our local high school.
- Tuesday & Thursday evenings from 6:30 - 8:30pm.
- FREE and accessible for all.
- Long term care centre drives in the elderly.
- High school students are volunteers.
- Deep River population = 4200, and we had 450+ people walking the halls last winter. Families walk together; expectant mothers, stroke recovery patients, etc.

**How long** has this initiative been in place?

- Launched last year Jan – April 2007
- Launch this year Oct - March 2008

What would you say has been the **greatest success** of this initiative?

- Wildly successful due to no barriers - free to all.
- We created a warm, safe, well-lit place for people to walk.
- The social aspect was very important, (esp. for seniors).
- Community groups joined us, i.e. Dietician with Canadian Food Guide display; Renfrew Health District; Tai Chi Club, Osteoporosis, etc.

What would you say has been the **biggest barrier or challenge** in implementing this initiative?

- The caretakers at the school - make sure they are on board. Can be a challenge but it can be done!
- Ensure all walkers respect the hallways (littering, snow boots, etc).

If you could offer **one piece of advice** to your colleagues who might be interested in implementing a similar initiative, what would it be?

- Go for it! Every community has a high school - hallways are not used in the evenings. This is more social than mall walking because it is more organized.
- Use PA system for music, tips on walking
- You need a champion!

What is the **title** of your initiative? *PPL40F Grade 12 Women in Leisure and Recreation*

Give us a **snapshot** of what it's about – what organizations are involved, who it's targeting...

- Because there are a huge number of girls dropping out of or not taking senior phys-ed courses, we decided to create a "women in leisure" alternative to phys-ed.
- Any female grade 10-12 could take this class to do physical activity that does not involve sports. Their activities would include a walking program, aerobics, weight training, yoga, dance, etc.

**How long** has this initiative been in place? 2 years

What would you say has been the **greatest success** of this initiative?

- Girls who hate sports and/or the competitive nature of them get an introduction to active living activities that they can continue outside of the school setting on their own.
- We use the girls to do QDPE with our neighbouring elementary schools. I teach them dances/activities etc., from CIRA and OPHEA and we schedule visits with teachers where the students teach the elementary students.
- The teachers love it because they do not have to do the planning for QDPE and the girls enjoy the interaction with the children. (The barrier is that the grade 12 teacher has to do a lot of "leg" work to prepare the group to go over). Most importantly, the elementary kids can't wait for us to come!

What would you say has been the **biggest barrier or challenge** in implementing this initiative?

- We are limited to offering this course every second year because of class sizes.
- Too many options for students make a lot of small classes that may be cut later.
- The other barrier is the wrong kids taking the class (ex. Grade 9 dropouts, skippers, etc)
- Administration must buy-in

If you could offer **one piece of advice** to your colleagues who might be interested in implementing a similar initiative, what would it be?

- The benefits far outweigh the challenges.
- As long as you lay out a daily and weekly schedule, allow the girls to choose the activities that they are interested in and generate personal goals, they will buy in and love it!
